

# Milky Way Cowl

Pattern for a cozy knitted cowl with a gradient galaxy-like pattern.  
The finished scarf has a circumference of ca. 24" and a width of 12".



## Supplies:

- 2 colours of yarn (20 stitches = 10cm/4", about 75m/50g), 75g of colour 1 and 60g of colour 2
- US 7/4,5mm and US 8/5mm needles
- Stitch markers, scissors and a tapestry needle

## Let's knit:

Cast on 88 stitches with the smaller needles in the colour you prefer for the edging – I chose the darker one (colour 1).

Connect to a round. Place a marker at the beginning of the round and if needed in between for the pattern.

\*K1 P1\* for about 1".

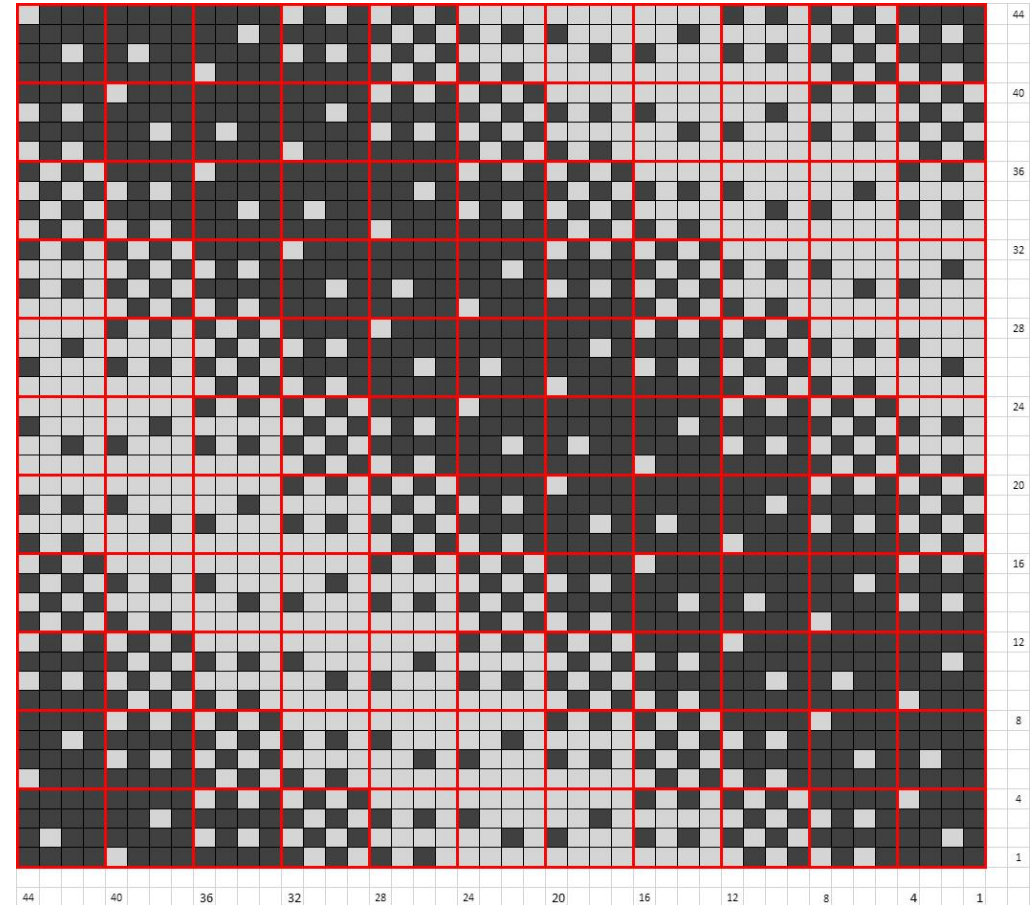
Knit the pattern seen on the right. As the numbers of stitches suggests, place 2 repeats of the pattern next to each other.

To create a nice inside for my cowl I wrapped the threads around each other after every second stitch. Of course you can use any other method to handle the floats.

When you are finished the pattern \*K1 P1\* for about 1" as you did in the beginning.

Then use an elastic bind off and then sew in the loose ends.
